RE: Withdrawal of Advice Letter 65-E, 2024 Budget Request and Marketing, Education and Outreach Plan for the Disadvantaged Communities Green Tariff and the Community Solar Green Tariff Programs

Dear Energy Division Tariff Unit:

In accordance with General Order 96-B, Section 5.3, Marin Clean Energy (MCE) hereby withdraws the above-referenced advice letter without prejudice.

On February 1, 2023, MCE submitted Advice Letter (AL) 65-E, which is currently being reviewed by Commission staff. MCE withdraws this advice letter because the Joint CCAs' request for an extension to submit their annual budget ALs until April 3, 2023 was granted on February 1, 2023, after MCE's submission of the Advice Letter. MCE expects to get additional information from PG&E related to CCA integration costs that will improve the forecast of budget needs in AL 65-E. A two-month extension will allow sufficient time for MCE to submit a more accurate prior-year budget actuals in one AL package in an efficient manner and prevent unnecessary amendments to the submitted budget. MCE withdraws Advice Letter 65-E and will submit a new advice letter by the new deadline of April 3, 2023. In accordance with General Order 96-B, Section 5.3, this withdrawal letter is being submitted in the same manner and served on the same persons as the advice letter.
