



## Responses to Questions Submitted for RFP 2024-03 for Community Partnership Program

1. Are cities eligible to apply? Or would it need to be a non-profit applying that could partner with the City?  
Yes, municipal partners are encouraged to apply. This includes cities, towns, and counties. Other local government entities also qualify.
2. It appears that the Proposed Work Plan, Timeline, and Budget are supposed to be submitted on a single document, as cited in the "MCE Community Outreach Program Workplan Template" that was provided. Is that correct?  
Yes, that is correct.
3. Would a proposal that is more local and does not focus on a County-wide campaign and outreach be considered by MCE?  
Yes, the outreach initiatives do not have to be service area wide. This is a factor in the decision-making process but if your initiative provides other benefits that outweigh the benefits of service-area wide outreach that will be factored in.
4. Is there a list of eligible/ineligible costs?

5. Are we allowed to submit multiple applications for distinctly different projects?  
Yes.
6. Is it acceptable for us to add/augment this template to provide additional information that MCE may not currently be asking for right now? Is it possible to submit more than one proposal or to apply for more than one grant?
