These comments are submitted on behalf of the thirty-plus members of the Larkspur Climate Group, a community-based organization formed in 2021 to provide a community voice on climate-related matters affecting Larkspur.

We have read with concern the recent reports of financial and governance issues at MCE. In this context, we commend the Board of Directors for deciding to form a standing Finance Committee. Further, we encourage the Board to name to that committee Board members with appropriate expertise, knowledge, and qualifications to provide effective oversight and guidance on financial matters.

We also want to encourage the Board to retain an independent consultant to conduct a full governance review. For transparency, we believe this consultant should be under the sole direction of the Board. At this point in MCE's 15-year history, which includes significant geographic expansion, such a full governance review appears overdue. This can be a strong step toward stabilizing MCE's financial condition and lead to lower pricing for cleaner energy for MCE's customers, particularly those in underserved communities.

Thank you for all you do to help guide MCE in its mission to confront the climate crisis by eliminating fossil fuel greenhouse gas emissions, producing renewable energy, and creating equitable community benefits. We appreciate your consideration of these recommendations.
