- Price
- Emissions Factor
- Resource Type
- Firm vs. Unit Contingent deliveries
- Supplier's acceptance of terms as outlined in the WSPP or EEI standard form agreements



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- Supplier's creditworthiness
- Supplier's track record of providing similar products

Any products that are offered outside of what is requested in this RFO will be considered on a case-by-case basis determined solely by MCE.
